Hilary Bradbury, Ph.D., is a scholar-practitioner focused on human and organizational dimensions of creating healthy communities. A professor of organization studies since 1998 (Case Western, USC and OHSU in Portland), today she is editor in chief of Action Research Journal (Sage). Hilary was born and bred in Dublin, Ireland and educated at Trinity College, Divinity School at Harvard and University of Chicago. She earned her PHD at Boston College's School of Management with a focus on change and transformation. Author of numerous journal articles and editor of the successful Handbooks of Action Research, she recently coauthored Eros/Power: Love in the Spirit of Inquiry (with Bill Torbert, 2016). Hilary convenes AR+ actionresearchplus.com, a global community for
